- I have completed UCLA Extension's ALC AIEP Level 107 (or higher), and earned grades of A- (or higher) in the two core subjects, and will complete ESL X433C: Advanced Academic Writing and Presentation Skills.

NOTE: UCLA Extension policy allows some students from our Academic Intensive English Program (AIEP) to request a waiver from providing an English language test for admission into some UCLA Extension certificate programs, however an additional course (ESL X433C: Advanced Academic Writing and Presentation Skills) is required.

This test waiver applies solely to UCLA Extension certificate programs requiring TOEFL scores 83-89 or IELTS Academic score 6.5 or iTEP Academic score 4.5-4.9. It does not apply to certificate programs requiring 90 (or higher) on the TOEFL or 7.0 (or higher) on the IELTS Academic or 5.0 (or higher) on the iTEP Academic.

Please submit transcripts showing completion of AIEP and grades earned. We recommend completing the requirement of ESL X433C: Advanced Academic Writing and Presentation Skills as soon as possible upon commencing a certificate program.
